The results of the criminal record check are sent to the Kitimat Youth Soccer Association via email.

This online module is the first part of any of the Grassroots Coaching Courses offered by Canada Soccer. Select the course appropriate to the age group you will be coaching: Active Start (U4 to U6), FUNdamentals (Boys U6-U9 and Girls U6-U8), Learn to Train (Boys U9-U12 and Girls U8-U11) and Soccer for Life (Boys U13+ and Girls U12+).

BC Soccer tracks certification levels for you in our course management system called Coach Centre.

Please follow these steps to ensure that we have your accurate details to credit your account:

1. [Create a Coach Centre account](#). If you already have one, please proceed to step 2.
2. You must use the same Coach Centre credentials (full name and email address must match) when registering for the [online theory \(PART 1\)](#).
3. Once you have completed the Coaching Soccer in Canada module, it is recommended that you complete the full online theory course. After completing the whole course, you will be able to register* for the [on-field practical workshop \(PART 2\)](#) to complete your full certification.
